Child Care Adjusting to Changes in Care Recommendations

Due to changes in care recommendations for centers, the following adjustments have been made:

- Field trips have been postponed until further notice.
- Faith studies will continue in the classroom on a daily basis, but we will
 not hold group chapel until further notice.
- We have asked our elective programs, Stretch-n-Grow and Educational Dance Express, to suspend programming temporarily thus reducing outside contact.
- We are limiting classroom sizes to 10 children or less.
- Gym and playground time is also being monitored and adjusted to accommodate smaller groups
