#### Lunch \$

Don't forget to put money on your child's lunch account. You can access their account at <u>TADS</u> <u>Educate</u> and use a debit/credit card or by sending cash/check to the school office. Simply place \$ in an envelope and write office-lunch account with your child's name.

### **Drop Off**

Families are encouraged to drop off at the west door each morning. Please note that students should not enter the building until 8:15 am unless they are signed up for our Before Care program. As noted in our Operating Plan, students can enter between 8:15 and 8:30 and go directly to their classroom. (Kindergarten families- please note your special drop off in the gym for the first 6 days of school-see emails).

### **Pick Up Procedure**

Here is a <u>map</u> to help you with the traffic flow for pick up of your elementary student(s). Dismissal is at 3:30 pm and we ask that parents remain in their vehicles (do not walk up) and pull up and a teacher will assist in getting your child in the vehicle. Siblings will be together at the youngest child's class location.



#### **Lunch Menu**

The August elementary <u>lunch menu</u> is available. The price of a student hot or alternate lunch which includes a milk is \$3.05 as of Aug 1st. Milk will remain the same at \$.45. An adult lunch will also remain the same at \$3.75.

### Medication

If you have medication to drop off for your child, you can do so anytime in the School Office, Monday thru Friday, 7 am to 4 pm. Medication must be in its original container along with the <u>completed form</u>. (Fill in all blanks from left to right over to the parent approval-signature column).

# Before & After Care and Yankee Hill Bus Transportation Sign Up

In case you missed it in your email, sign up is now available for fall for our Before & After School program at both campuses. We are also adding transportation daily from our Yankee Hill campus and back for Elementary students for a small (subsidized) fee.

### Supplemental Supplies

Each student is asked to bring the supplemental supplies as noted on the <u>list</u> for their grade. We understand that sanitizing wipes are in high demand, so please do not be concerned if you are unable to locate any prior to the start of school.

### **Volunteer Requirements**

Effective July 1st, all volunteers of Christ Lincoln Church and Schools will need to complete a Volunteer Release and Waiver Liability Form. If driving for an event you will need to provide a valid driver's license, current insurance, motor vehicle record (MVR from the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles) and Protect My Ministry background check (every 3 yrs). You will want to have license, insurance and MVR at your fingertips prior to sitting down to complete the form.
