Grades K-5 Saturday, March 4, 9 am -12 pm

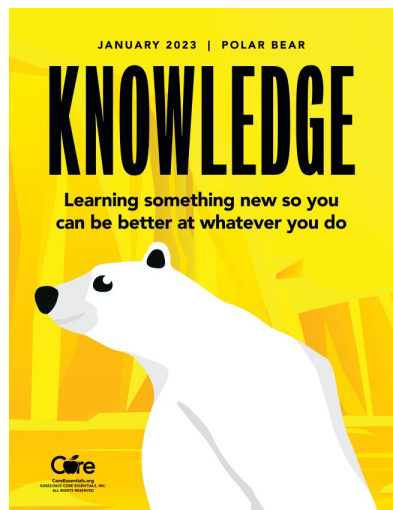
