WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

At Christ Lincoln Schools we seek to help develop the next generation of Christian believers and leaders. We know the faith and beliefs taught and developed in these critical developmental years, will continue to grow throughout their lives.

LIVING OUT OUR MISSION

prayer

From day one, students are taught and encouraged to pray in their classrooms, before and after meals, and anytime prayer might be needed.

faith studies

Every day, at every grade level, our students have Faith Studies as part of the daily curriculum. Here, in grade appropriate ways, our students delve into Biblical stories, exploring the history, context and meaning of the heroes (and villains) in the Bible. Our students learn about how God is at work in each of our lives just as he was at work in the lives of those recorded in the Bible.

theme verse

Each school year, the Lutheran Schools of Lincoln share a biblical theme verse. We use that verse as a jumping off point to discuss how living out our faith has a positive impact on ourselves, our families and our community. We challenge our students to find ways to apply the verse to their experiences.

Love JESUS

Christ Lincoln's mission is the "Connect People to Christ and Together Grow in His Word". At Christ Lincoln Schools, we exist to come alongside families to build upon the faith they have begun in their homes.

We are members of the Lutheran Church, Missouri Synod, but we are blessed to serve families from a wide variety of faith backgrounds. Our religious instruction is Christian and we teach the Bible as God's word.

Our goal is to simply lead our children to Love Jesus throughout their lives!

01 WEEKLY CHAPEL

Every Thursday, our whole student body joins together in a time of worship at our weekly Chapels. Led by our pastors, church workers, classrooms, and outside guests, we focus our time on God's kingdom and what He teaches in His word.

02 CHARACTER EDUCATION

We utilize and teach the Core Essentials Program for our character education. A word of character is introduced in chapel and taught and developed in classrooms throughout the month.

03 DISCIPLINE

All discipline in the classrooms, halls, and playgrounds is rooted in grace. We get to show grace through loving correction because God showed grace to each of us.

SERVICE

Being the “hands and feet” of Jesus is a core Christian practice. We are all called to not just know what Jesus said, but to live like Him!

Through classroom service projects like making cards for our Cancer Care ministry, bringing diaper donations for a local diaper ministry, helping to clean up our campus, or simply helping our fellow classmates and teachers in the classroom, our students are taught how to become future leaders of service in their communities.

We actively seek out mission serving opportunities for each of our grade levels. With pinnacle service opportunities coming at the 5th grade level where students are asked to serve as leaders of the school and participate in monthly out of school service.

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gift of the word and bible buddies

At the beginning of 2nd grade, each student is presented their very own Bible by one of our church's women's bible study groups. They are then assigned a 5th grader who becomes their “Bible Buddy” and spends time with them teaching them how to read and use those Bibles. Our students use those Bibles throughout their time at Christ and beyond!



Love OTHERS

Our students are learning how to be productive members and leaders in society. We bring a “mission-minded” approach to our teaching and guidance.

You will often hear teachers correcting behavior using verbiage like: “How is jumping in line showing our friends that we love them?”

We want to model Jesus’ love, care and service to our friends within our school, our teachers, our families outside school and our greater community and world!

GROWING BEYOND

As a nationally accredited school (NLSA), our curriculum fulfills all Nebraska state and national curriculum standards. Your child will be taught the same materials as in any public school, but through a biblical worldview.

But meeting the "standard" isn't enough. We challenge our students academically, preparing them for excellence in and out of the classroom at their next level of learning. We are Growing Beyond!

Our advantage? Our smaller class sizes mean our excellent teaching staff can make appropriate differentiation in academic subject areas and reading groups.

All our students participate in MAP Testing. Our students consistently score above BOTH national and local averages. Our teachers use MAP testing to measure what the student is ready to learn - providing guided and individualized learning opportunities.

For students with special learning needs, we partner with LPS for support in speech, occupational therapy, and other learning services.
